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| 1 | Submit a NORD form to DLR Submit an initial draft of the regulations to DLR | COMPLETED BY: CITY AGENCY Submission of the Notice of Regulation Development (NORD) will initiate the promulgation process by: • Creating a formal record of an Agency's intention to create, amend, or repeal a regulation; and • Allowing the City Solicitor to approve the legality of an Agency's intention to create, amend, or repeal a regulation. |
| 2 | Obtain initial approval from DLR and CIty Solicitor | COMPLETED BY: DLR DLR will review and approve the submitted materials and handle submission of the materials to the City Solicitor's office for review and approval. |

| 3 | Complete drafting with DLR | DLR will engage in a collaborative editing process with the Agency to refine a draft of the proposed regulations in COBRA formatting. PLEASE NOTE: Agency work capacities and the length/complexity of a set of regulations will affect the timeline for completion of this step. |

| 4 | Obtain final approval from City Solicitor | When a draft of a proposed regulation is agreed upon by DLR and the Agency, DLR will submit the draft to the City Solicitor for final approval. The City Solicitor will review the regulations for adherence to statutory authority and may make recommendations regarding the content of the regulations |

| 5 | Obtain final approval from City Administrator | When a draft of a proposed regulation has approval from both DLR and the City Solicitor, DLR will submit the draft to the City Administrator's Office for final approval. |

| 6 | Submit proposed regulation for inclusion in COBRA Register | When a proposed regulation has approval from DLR, the City Solicitor, and the City Administrator, an Agency may submit the regulation for inclusion in the COBRA Register to fulfill the required notice and comment period. For inclusion in the Register, an Agency must submit: • A Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA) form; and • A clean copy of the proposed regulations in the form required by DLR. |
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| 7 | COBRA REGISTER The proposed regulation is printed in the COBRA Register for a 30-day public notice and comment period | |

| 8 | If public feedback is incorporated, repeat steps 3-7 If unchanged or the change is *non-substantive, move to final step | PLEASE NOTE: Agencies will be responsible for collecting their own comments from the public during the notice and comment period. No public comments should be submitted to DLR. Comments received by City agencies should be retained in accordance with City retention policies. *Determination of non-substantive changes are made by City Solicitor |

| 9 | File with DLR for codification | Following the completion of the required notice and comment period, an Agency may file the regulations with the DLR director for codification in the Code of Baltimore Regulations Annotated, at which time the regulations will be effective. |
